We keep our Facebook page updated with photos and videos of the puppies once they are born. Everyone is assigned a collar color to help our families keep an eye on their future family member. This is the most efficient way we've found to keep everyone in the loop. We go live once or twice a week, helping us be more interactive. We set up a text message group with all the families of a litter and text photos, video, news etc throughout the week, as well as text individual pictures to our families. We like to schedule a brief phone interview with all our future families, it helps a get to know you and gives us an idea of what to look for in Puppy personalities. It's our version of Pug/Family Tinder. We are available Mon – Sat 12pm – 8pm, please let us know what day(s) and time(s) would work best for you so we can set it up.

We do require a \$200 non-refundable deposit to get on our wait list (will be applied to the price of your puppy). Once your application is approved, the deposit should be sent via Apple Pay, Zelle or Venmo. Once your puppy is born and you receive your notification, an additional non-refundable deposit of half the remaining price is due and must be received within 3 business days to hold your puppy. The deposit should be sent via Apple Pay, Zelle or Venmo Once we receive your deposit, we are assuming that the puppy has a home and is no longer

available. Should something happen to your puppy while in our care or puppy is not adoptable, deposit can be transferred to another future litter or we will refund your total deposit (this does not happen often at all and is the only circumstance where any refund will be issued). The balance on your puppy is due at pick up in cash (or in advance if being done electronically - cash is the preference).

For the safety of our puppies and our other dogs, we will not allow visitors until the puppy has had their first set of shots at around 6 weeks of age. You will select your puppy in your deposit order, around 4 weeks of age (we can do Factime or other video calls so you can "see" your puppy). Puppies will not be allowed to leave their mother until at least 10 weeks of age (and once the vet agrees that they are ready for their forever homes).

Puppies are wormed every two weeks starting at 2 weeks of age until they go home with you. They will have had their first two (of 4) vaccinations. We send everyone home with a puppy goody bag. You will need to pick up your puppy (or arrange for transport) by 12 weeks of age. After 10 weeks, unless arrangements are made well in advance, there is a \$25 daily boarding fee and, if another set of shots are needed to keep puppy on schedule, they are an additional \$25.

We are available 24/7/365 should you have any questions or concerns for the life of your puppy. We also have a Facebook Group for our families to post pictures, stay in touch with litter mates or post questions to other family members.

Puppies are sold under limited registration only and no breeding rights are given. By submitting and signing this application, you agree that you are 18 years of age or older and agree to the above guidelines.
